## St. Francis de Sales Prepares for 2015 Mission Trip

The St. Francis 2015 Appalachia Service Project Team is in full swing. Approximately 30 youth and 15 adult parishioners have signed up to be a part of this amazing year long program. Over the last several years, St. Francis has participated in the ASP program with Asbury United Methodist Church. This year due to the large number of St. Francis participants it was necessary for St. Francis to organize its own team. The team is very grateful to Asbury United Methodist Church for their continued support as St. Francis grows into it's ASP program.

The team will meet once a month throughout the year. They will attend the

5:30pm mass at St Francis and then meet for various team exercises. They will also be building at least two wheelchair ramps locally with Chesapeake Housing Mission. In June of 2015, 25 – 30 youth and 12-15 adults from St. Francis de Sales Parish will make the journey to West Virginia to do their part in making homes warmer, safer, and drier. The team will be working in areas of severe poverty replacing roofs that have fallen down, floors that have given way to rot, and walls that provide little protection from the harsh weather.

This mission is much more than construction and home repair. It is a



mission based on sharing Christ's love by lending a helping hand to those in need. It is about accepting people right where they are and just the way they are.

The St. Francis Team will need to raise over \$20,000 for the cost of the trip. They are in need of your support both financially and spiritually. Please keep the ASP team in your prayers!
